




The population of Ashton Hurst is just smaller than the Tameside average of 11,796 people. 59% of this population is between the ages of 16 and 64 years old, which is less than the borough average of 62%.

Since 2013, the under 16 and over 65 age groups have increased in size, while the working age population has decreased by almost 100 people.

The white population of Ashton Hurst is 85.4%, which is lower than the Tameside average of 91%. The black population equals the average value of 1%.



40% of GCSE students in Ashton Hurst achieve grades 5 and above in their English and Maths qualifications, which is fractionally below the Tameside average of 40.8%.

The ward has a higher-than-average school readiness percentage, with Tameside's average value being 66%.

21.3% of residents have no qualifications, which is above the Tameside average of 19%.



This map shows the deprivation rankings of the LSOAs (small areas of around 1500 people) which make up the ward. Those in decile 1 are within the top 10% deprived LSOAs in the country.

Ward Deprivation Score

31.6 (IMD 2015)

Ashton Hurst is more deprived than the Tameside average; the IMD deprivation score for Ashton Hurst is 31.6, which is higher than the borough's average score of 28.8.

The proportion of children living in poverty in the ward, 33.0%, is 3.5% above the Tameside average.

On average, 70% of adults in Tameside are employed, so Ashton Hurst's employment rate of 65.3% is below average for the borough, although the proportion of students is higher than the average value of 4.8%.







The majority of properties in Ashton Hurst are owner occupied, with average market sale prices slightly above the Tameside average of £139,412. The percentage of private rented homes in Ashton Hurst is lower than the Tameside average of 14.2%.

11.2% of households are in fuel poverty, which is above the average of 10.2%, however there are a below average number of homes without central heating installed; the Tameside average central heating installation percentage is 97.3%.

53.1% of the residences in Ashton Hurst are semi-detached houses or bungalows, this is much more than the Tameside average value of 37.5%.






Travel Time to the Nearest GP's Surgery in minutes

Hot Food Takeaways and Licenced Premises per 1000 People



Ashton Hurst has fewer hot food takeaways and licenced premises per 1000 people than the Tameside average, but has higher than average travel times to the nearest GP's surgery both with and without use of a car.

There are three GP's surgeries in the ward, all of which have been rated as good or outstanding by the Care Quality Commission, which monitors healthcare practices nationally.

Ashton Hurst doesn't contain any pharmacies, however those in the neighbouring wards mean that the area, like all of Tameside, has sufficient pharmacy access.










Ashton Hurst has above average hospital admission rates, particularly for self harm and admissions of children under five years old. The prevalence of child-hood obesity in reception class children is slightly higher than the Tameside average, but significantly fewer year six students are obese than the Tameside average percentage.

The biggest cause of death in Ashton Hurst is cancer, which is responsible for one in three of all deaths in the ward.

The male healthy life expectancy is higher than the Tameside average of 58.1 years, while the female healthy life expectancy is below the average value of 57.6 years old.





The total crime rate in Ashton Hurst is slightly below the Tameside average of 207.7 offences per 1000 people. Ashton Hurst has a lower rate of anti-social behaviour offences than the Tameside average, and also has a significantly smaller rate of theft per 1000 people. Although the rate of theft offences is much lower than average, it remains the third most committed crime in the ward.

Ashton Hurst has a significantly higher-than-average rate of domestic abuse offences reported to the police compared to Tameside as a whole, and domestic abuse is the most committed crime in the area.
