


Ashton St. Michael's Ward Profile 2019




The population of Ashton St Michael's is just greater than the Tameside average of 11,796 people. 64% of this population is between the ages of 16 and 64 years old, which is more than the borough average of 62%.

Since 2013, all three of the wide age bands have increased in size by 100 to 200 people.

The white population of Ashton St Michael's is 81%, which is lower than the Tameside average of 85.9%. The Indian and Pakistani proportions of the ward's population are both significantly larger than the borough averages of 2.0% each.



Percentage of "good passes" (grades 5+) in GCSE English and Maths



42.5% of GCSE students in Ashton St Michael's achieve grades 5 and above in their English and Maths qualifications, which is better than the Tameside average of 40.8%.

The ward has a lower-than-average school readiness percentage, with Tameside's average value being slightly higher at 66%.

20.5% of residents have no qualifications, which is above the Tameside average of 19%.




This map shows the deprivation rankings of the LSOAs (small areas of around 1500 people) which make up the ward. Those in decile 1 are within the top 10% deprived LSOAs in the country.

Ashton St Michael's is more deprived than the Tameside average; the IMD deprivation score for Ashton St Michael's is 35.2, which is higher than the borough's average score of 28.8.

The proportion of children living in poverty in the ward, 30.0%, is above the Tameside average by just 0.5%.

On average, 70% of adults in Tameside are employed, so the ward's employment rate of 67.1% is below average for the borough, although the proportion of students is higher than the average value of 4.8%.




Mean House Sale Prices



The majority of properties in Ashton St Michael's are owner occupied, with average market sale prices significantly below the Tameside average of £139,412. The percentage of private rented homes in Ashton St Michael's is higher than the Tameside average of 14.2%.

11.4% of households are in fuel poverty, which is above the average of 10.2%, and there is an above average number of homes without central heating installed; the Tameside average central heating installation percentage is 97.3%.

50.5% of the residences in Ashton St Michael's are semi-detached houses or bungalows, this is much more than the Tameside average value of 37.5%.






Travel Time to the Nearest GP's Surgery in minutes

Ashton St Michael's has significantly fewer hot food takeaways per 1000 people than the Tameside average, but has more licenced premises per 1000 people than average. Travel times to the nearest GP's surgery are lower than average both with and without the use of a car.

There are three GP's surgeries in the ward, all of which have been rated as good or outstanding by the Care Quality Commission, which monitors healthcare practices nationally.

The ward, along with the borough as a whole, has good pharmacy access.





Hospital Admission Rates per 100,000 people




Ashton St Michael's has above average hospital admission rates for self harm, alcohol related harm, and admissions of children under five years old. The prevalence of childhood obesity in reception class matches the Tameside average, but fewer year six students are obese than the Tameside average percentage.

The biggest cause of death in Ashton St Michael's is cancer, which is responsible for one in four of all deaths in the ward.

The male healthy life expectancy is less than the Tameside average of 58.1 years, while the female healthy life expectancy is above the average value of 57.6 years old.





The total crime rate in Ashton St Michael's is significantly greater than the Tameside average of 207.7 offences per 1000 people. The ward has a higher rate of anti-social behaviour offences than the Tameside average, and also has a greater than average rate of violent and sexual offences per 1000 people, constituting the second most committed crime in the ward.

Ashton St Michael's has a significantly higher-than-average rate of domestic abuse offences reported to the police compared to Tameside as a whole, and domestic abuse is the most committed crime in the area.
