




The population of Longdendale is smaller than the Tameside average of 11,796 people. 60.5% of this population is between the ages of 16 and 64 years old, which is less than the borough average of 62%.

Since 2013, the under 16 and over 65 age groups have both increased in size by around 100 people, while the working age population has been stagnant.

The white population of Longdendale is 97.1%, which is greater than the Tameside average of 91%. All the other major population groups make up a smaller proportion of the ward's population than on average across Tameside.



## Percentage of "good passes" (grades 5+) in GCSE English and Maths



26.7% of GCSE students in Longdendale achieve grades 5 and above in their English and Maths qualifications, which is significantly below the Tameside average of 40.8%.

The ward has a lower-than-average school readiness percentage, with Tameside's average value being 66%.

21.7% of residents have no qualifications, which is above the Tameside average of 19%.



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This map shows the deprivation rankings of the LSOAs (small areas of around 1500 people) which make up the ward. Those in decile 1 are within the top 10% deprived LSOAs in the country.

Longdendale is more deprived than the Tameside average; the IMD deprivation score for Longdendale is 33.0, which is higher than the borough's average score of 28.8.

The proportion of children living in poverty in the ward, 34.0%, is 4.5% above the Tameside average.

On average, 70% of adults in Tameside are employed, so Longdendale's employment rate of 65.3% is below average for the borough.

The proportion of students is just lower than the average value of 4.8%.




## Mean House Sale Prices



The majority of properties in Longdendale are owner occupied, with average market sale prices below the Tameside average of £139,412. The percentage of private rented homes in Longdendale is lower than the Tameside average of 14.2%.

11.2% of households are in fuel poverty, which is above the average of 10.2%, however there are a below average number of homes without central heating installed; the Tameside average central heating installation percentage is 97.3%.

48.2% of the residences in Longdendale are terraced houses or bungalows, this is much more than the Tameside average value of 35.7%.






## Travel Time to the Nearest GP's Surgery in minutes

Longdendale has significantly fewer hot food takeaways per 1000 people than the Tameside average, and has lower-than-average travel times to the nearest GP's surgery both with and without the use of a car.

There are three GP's surgeries in the ward, all of which have been rated as good or outstanding by the Care Quality Commission, which monitors healthcare practices nationally.

Longdendale contains five pharmacies and the area, like all of Tameside, has sufficient pharmacy access.





## Hospital Admission Rates per 100,000 people




Longdendale has an above average hospital admission rate for self harm. The prevalence of childhood obesity in reception class children is in line with the Tameside average, but fewer year six students are obese than the Tameside average percentage.

The biggest cause of death in Longdendale is cancer, which is responsible for one in three of all deaths in the ward.

The male healthy life expectancy is below the Tameside average of 58.1 years, while the female healthy life expectancy is greater than the average value of 57.6 years old.





The total crime rate in Longdendale is lower than the Tameside average of 207.7 offences per 1000 people. Longdendale has a below average rate of anti-social behaviour offences than the Tameside average, and also has a significantly smaller rate of domestic abuse per 1000 people. Although the rate of theft offences is much lower than average, it remains the third most committed crime in the ward.

Longdendale has a lower-than-average rate of violent and sexual offences reported to the police compared to Tameside as a whole, but violent and sexual offences are the most committed crimes in the area.
